

Mandate, Outcomes, and Service Delivery Model

Mandate

The Provincial Outreach Program for the Early Years (POPEY) is a British Columbia Ministry of Education & Child Care Provincial Resource Program (PRP) with an outreach focus.

POPEY's mandate is to increase K-3 educators' capacity to support all primary English literacy learners, including diverse learners, in an inclusive classroom setting.

Outcomes

- 1. Build and sustain the capacity of K-3 educators throughout the province in the area of effective, inclusive literacy instruction.
- 2. Provide K-3 educators with support, knowledge and professional learning opportunities in the area of effective literacy instruction in an inclusive classroom setting.
- 3. Research, evaluate and share evidence-based practice and resources for educating all K-3 students, including diverse learners, in the area of early literacy.
- 4. Liaise with District Partners, professional associations, and other stakeholders in British Columbia education.
- 5. Provide educators with online access to information, eLearning videos, resources and professional learning opportunities.
- 6. Facilitate the sharing and transferring of knowledge and practice among educators across the province.

Service Delivery

POPEY provides services to BC public school districts, Group I and II independent schools, and non-Independent First Nations Schools.

The focus of **POPEY**'s services is to build capacity within districts and schools through face-to-face and online workshops, resources and provincial networking.

The **POPEY** team is comprised of a Program Manager/Teacher Consultant, one full-time Teacher Consultant, and one part-time Teacher Consultant.

POPEY receives support from a Communications Coordinator, an Administrative Assistant, and a Supervising Administrator from the Host School District - Richmond School District.
